# **Canton Emergency Shelter GO KIT**

If the Town of Canton declared a state of emergency and opened the Canton Emergency Shelter, the following guidelines should be followed by you and your family.

Ensure there are sufficient quantities for you and each family member

- Personal Identification
- Canned Food or Packaged food in original container
- Prescription Medications / Treatments

2 Week supply of medicine in original containers Small cooler of ice, if refrigeration is needed for medication If using oxygen, bring your concentrator & as many full, portable tanks as possible

## Bedding

Lightweight cot Blankets / Sleeping bags / Pillows / Sheets

#### Flashlights & Portable Radio

Plenty of extra batteries

#### Clothing

Clothing for one week Rain gear

### • Personal Care Items

Towels, washcloths & soap, Diapers
Toiletries / other personal care or feminine hygiene items

- Spare Eyeglasses/Contacts including supplies
- Traveler's checks
- Special Needs Special dietary foods, baby foods, etc.

#### **NOTES:**

- **DO NOT LEAVE YOUR HOME** UNTIL TOWN GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS ANNOUNCE on radio, television or other form of communication or you verify by contacting emergency officials by phone that a particular shelter is open.
- DO NOT BRING: Weapons, Illegal Drugs or Alcohol
- Shelters will be available for people who have no other place to go. Shelters may be crowded and uncomfortable with limited privacy and electricity
- The Town of Canton Shelter is located at 40 Dyer Ave Canton CT, at the Canton Community Center.
