Public Information:The Hartford Marathon Foundation, with support from local sponsors, offers a<br/>10K road race which will end on the "Rails to Trails" in the downtown Collinsville<br/>area. This athletic event begins with a race start of 0830 hours in Burlington,<br/>continues through Farmington and enters the "Rails to Trails". The participants<br/>then continue on the "Rails to Trails" into Canton and finish in Collinsville on the<br/>"Rails to Trails" prior to Main Street. There will be no running of the course on<br/>any Canton roadway. There will be exhibitors, food and race booths placed in<br/>the Town Hall parking lot. See attached Addendums for Collinsville Event<br/>Layout, race route, schedule of events, and Traffic Advisory.

The event, road closures and traffic advisories will be publicized by the event sponsor, the Town of Canton website, Town of Canton Social Media and QNotify.

<u>Assignments</u> :	Between 0700hrs and 1030hrs one Canton Police Officer will be assigned to the pedestrian cross walk on Bridge Street @ Main (CERT will provide two to four personnel at a time to assist as able). The crosswalk Officer will provide safety to pedestrians and facilitate participant's access to shuttle buses on Bridge Street. The traffic control signal should be placed on flash while traffic direction is being accomplished by hand.
	During the loading of the shuttle buses one or more CERT members will remain on the sidewalk on Bridge Street assisting runners getting onto buses. After race begins one or more CERT members will remain at the no parking zone as buses will return to park. Upon completion of the race some runners will return and board buses at Bridge Street for transport back to the starting line.
	Ofc. Tebecio will be point of contact for CERT members assigned.
	Any event related issues identified by CERT personnel will be directed to Canton Police Detail Personnel for disposition.
