Dear Canton Resident:

Beginning September 1st, our office will be providing intake appointments for those interested in applying for energy assistance for the 2024-2025 cold weather season.

**The Connecticut Energy Assistance Program (CEAP) helps households pay for primary heating bills. This program is designed for people who rent, people who are homeowners, and people who rent and have heat included as well.*

CEAP benefits are available to eligible households with incomes at or below 60% of the state median income.

60% of 2024 STATE MEDIAN INCOME GUIDELINES

For those who come in for an intake and are NOT deemed eligible for the statewide program but are struggling to pay their heating bills, there may still be help available to you through local funding resources, such as the Canton Emergency Fuel Bank.
